

DISHES FOR MASTER CHEFS

In the wake of the immense success television programmes are experiencing on the theme of cooking and recipes, Infinito is born recently with HQ in Castelvechio di Monte Porzio in the province of Pesaro Urbino in Italy which has focused on producing attractive accessories with which to embellish dining tables. Each piece is rigorously manufactured in block wood and Krion which is an acrylic stone because a plate is not only a container on which to put food but is also a decorative element which confers a distinct style which is in every case special and elegant. Infinito's project goes back to 2010 and to three brothers well firstly Laura Carboni who master-minded the project and Luigi and Carlo technicians and experts in production. The resulting collections with the involvement of architect designers in the field are exclusively all "Made in Italy" and are the following three: Quadrilatero, TeGusto and Legno.

Quadrilatero is the first one presented by the company and is made up of a variety of wooden accessories which blend harmoniously with more modern materials bringing out new essential and elegant shapes. Furthermore Quadrilatero allows you to put together several tastes into the same plate leaving each one unaltered to your palate.

TeGusto is a collection which derives from joint work with designer Cristina Zanni which was devised to allow the end users the freedom to interpret and express their fantasies by way of putting together plates and accessories which best suited to the time of day, for sweet and salty dishes, to bring together sweet and sour with side dishes and different garnishes. Legno is the ideal collection by which to bring to the table part of our environment, which can be warm, realistic, perfumed and which recalls things "green" and to live in harmony with "green".

Every product by Infinito has been made from selected materials. The essences deployed in the Quadrilatero and legno collections are FSC certified and come from controlled plantations while Krion Solid Surface is a new generation material developed by Systempool, a Gruppo Porcelanosa company. To your touch the solid surface feels like natural stone but is in fact a composite material made up by two thirds of natural minerals (ATH: aluminium trihydrate) and with a small percentage of highly resistant resins. This make up means Krion is not porous, is bacteria

free, with proven toughness, durability and reduced maintenance, is easy to repair and to keep clean. This material is 100% recyclable and is available in a vast selection of colours.
